

The Board has had under consideration the proposals of several of the Banks to loan Money to the State of Maryland, under a Resolve of the late Session of the General Assembly, and authorizes the Treasurer of the Western Shore, to negotiate in behalf of the State Loans of the following Banks, and upon the terms mentioned in the proposals. of the Farmers Bank of Maryland payable now one hundred thousand Dollars. of the Bank of Baltimore thirty thousand Dollars payable now and twenty thousand Dollars payable the first of December. of the Commercial and Farmers Bank payable now twenty thousand Dollars. of the Union Bank of Maryland twenty five thousand Dollars now and twenty five thousand Dollars the first of January. of the Farmers and Merchants Bank thirty thousand Dollars now and twenty thousand Dollars the first day of October. of the Marine Bank ten thousand Dollars now and of the Bank of Maryland twenty thousand Dollars.

The Treasurer of the Western Shore, is authorized to borrow in behalf of the State, from Messieurs George and John Barber seven thousand Dollars, at six per cent per annum interest payable semiannually.
