Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs  
S. and B. Gough twenty seven Dollars and twenty five cents the amount of  
the account exhibited by them for Gun Powder furnished for the use of the  
Militia of Saint Marys County as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Brigadier General  
Osborn Williams seventy Dollars and thirty three cents for pay rations and  
forage as per account filed.

forty canteens for the use of the Militia.
