Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for on the settlement of his Account as Armourer.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis send to Prince Georges County two hundred and forty Muskets the like number of Cartouch Boxes, two thousand eight hundred and eighty cartridges and seven hundred and twenty flints for the use of the Militia

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Norman Pinkney three hundred Dollars out of the Contingent Fund to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Daniel Henckels thirteen thousand one hundred and two Dollars the amount of Joseph Henry's two Accounts for Muskets, Swords and so forth purchased of him by M^r John Shaw for the use of the State of Maryland.

Monday July the 20 1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis send to Parrot Marys County sixty Swords, forty Pistols, five Camp Kettles, one hundred and twenty five Flints, fifteen Sword Belts and one hundred and fifty cartridges.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis forward to Charles County forty Pistols, one hundred and fifty cartridges, five Camp Kettles, one hundred and twenty five Flints and fifteen Sword Belts.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Snowden nine hundred and twenty five Dollars for flour furnished Contractors Hall and Hunt for the use of the Militia as per account filed.
