Friday July the 24 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw the sum of fifty nine Dollars and ninety five cents and one quarter as per account passed.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Ezekiel F. Chambers the sum of two thousand six hundred and seventeen Dollars and two and five cents the amount of an account for Muskets, Powder and so forth.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nathaniel F. Williams one hundred and two Dollars and seventy three cents for freight of Rifles Pistols Knapsacks and canteens from Philadelphia to Baltimore as per account filed.

Robert C. Magruder was appointed a Judge of the Orphans Court for Montgomery County in the Room of Richard Anderson resigned and Commission issued to Thomas Davis Bruce Selby and Robert C. Magruder as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Beziir Spurrier the sum of fifteen Dollars for the rent of Magazine as per account passed and filed.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Horatio G. Murroe one shilling one pound seven shillings and three pence for articles furnished for the use of the Executive Department as per account passed by the Auditor General.
