

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Hutchison five Dollars for riding Express to procure Waggons to remove the public Records to Upper Marlborough as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Hodges the sum of five Dollars for riding Express to procure Waggons to remove public Records to Upper Marlborough as per Account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Beckly the sum of Ninety six Dollars and Ninety three and Three fourth Cents for supplies furnished the draughted Militia on their march to Baltimore as per Accounts.

The Board proceeded to elect a Chief Judge of the Court of Oyer and Terminer and Gaol Delivery for Baltimore County vice John Scott Esquire deceased. The Ballots being deposited in the Ballot Box on examination thereof it appeared that the honorable Luther Martin had every Vote. Whereupon it is declared in the Council that the said Luther Martin is duly elected Chief Judge of the said Court and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Friday August the 13th 1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Maguider William H. Ward William B. Martin & Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Butler the sum of forty Dollars for transporting the provision and Baggage of the draughted men under the command of Colonel William C. Miller on their march to Baltimore as per Account filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Thomas Hood forty nine Dollars and forty two Cents for provisions and transporting Baggage of Militia to Annapolis as per Account filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Charles D. Warfield three Dollars and eighty seven Cents the amount of his pay for services at Annapolis in May last as per Account filed.
