Saturday August the 16: 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William H. Ward William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain John Hall three hundred and fifty two Dollars and fifty cents the amount of pay due the Troop of Horse commanded by him for services at Annapolis in April last as per Pay Roll.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer Esquire Pay Master to the twenty second Regiment five hundred and eighteen Dollars and thirty cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by William S. Green for services in April last at Annapolis as per Pay Roll.

ordered that Mr. Henry Deringer send to the address of William H. Ward Esquire fifty Rifles and forty Pistols for the use of the Militia of Cecil County two hundred Muskets and forty Swords to be sent A. Henry and two hundred Cartouch Boxes, thirty five Holsters, twenty tents, thirty Camp Kettles six yards of Match Rope to be sent to the same address by Brigade Quarter Master Richard Waters.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Williams Esquire two hundred and thirty five Dollars for two Horses purchased by him for the use of the State as per Account filed.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John H. Hall sixty six Dollars and seventy five cents the balance of his Account for hire of Waggons and for the removal of Records as his Account filed.
