Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Johnson thirteen Dollars and seventy five cents for horse hire and for the Militia as per account passed by the Auditor General.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain James Bruff twenty two pounds ten shillings for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Dawson ten Dollars for one quarters half pay due the first Instant.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Miriam Pinkney eighty seven Dollars and and sixty six cents the balance of her account for removing Public Records pay Expresses and for the Militia as per account and Vouchers lodged with the Auditor.

Monday August the 16 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William H. Ward, William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pinkney Esquire Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland fourteen Dollars and eighty seven and a half cents the amount of William Harrison Juniors account for transporting arms from Easton to Cambridge as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pinkney Esquire Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland one hundred and thirty five Dollars and sixty one cents the amount of John Adams account for supplies furnished the draught Militia on their March to Baltimore as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Gorman the sum of forty five Dollars the amount of his account for a horse purchased by Mr. Profs for the State as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Miriam Pinkney three hundred Dollars out of the Contingent Fund to be by her accounted for.
