Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Bowser six Dollars for transporting provisions and so forth to Thomas Point for the Militia as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Bowser twenty two Dollars for the use of his Cart and Horse employed in removing public Records as per account

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Rigby thirty seven Dollars and fifty Cents for going Express as per account filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry A. Chamberlain thirty six Dollars for supplies furnished the draughted Militia on their march to Baltimore in May last as per accounts passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M^r Abraham Sherman twelve Dollars for supplies furnished the draughted Militia on their March to Baltimore in May last as per account filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major William B. Beanes forty one Dollars for Expresses and transporting Arms as per account passed.

Wednesday August the 18. 1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander B. Magruder William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Hutchinson the sum of fifteen Dollars for transporting Muskets and so forth from Marlboro. to Piscataway as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Baldwin the
