Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Wigart ninety three dollars and seventy five cents for freight of arms from Philadelphia to Annapolis as per account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs Green and Company of Philadelphia fourteen hundred and fifty Dollars for one thousand Knapsacks and one thousand Canteens purchased in virtue of a Resolution passed at June Session eighteen hundred and twelve appropriating twenty thousand dollars as per account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs George and John Barber thirty Dollars and forty two cents for lead and Rope as per account filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to M<sup>r</sup> Joseph Sands twenty three Dollars and sixty nine and a half cents for sundries advanced for the use of the City Guard as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Messieurs James and William Glenn five hundred and forty two Dollars and twenty five cents for Cartouch Boxes, Pistol Holsters, Sword Belts and Cart Harness as per account.

Saturday August the 21/1813

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Thomas J. Wheeler fifty one Dollars and twenty seven cents the amount of pay and so forth allowed to him and to a number of his detachment of draughted Militia ordered to Annapolis in April last as per Pay Roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Basil Bowling sixty eight Dollars and eighty one and a half cents for supplies furnished the Companies commanded by Captain Hamilton and others on their march to Annapolis in August last as per account passed and filed.
