

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Joshua Wood twelve Dollars and one Cent the amount of pay due him for marching the detachment of Harford County Militia draughted in the United States service to Annapolis in April last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major John Meredith twenty one Dollars it being the amount paid by him to Thomas Cooper for carrying in his carriage George Bishop a British deserter to General Smith of Baltimore as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters two thousand four hundred and fifty one Dollars and fifty four cents it being the amount of an account for Military Stores purchased by him for the use of the State and enclosed in his letter of the 26 ultimo.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Standish Barry twelve hundred Dollars in part of his account for sundry Military Articles furnished by order of Major General Smith in August last and to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Margaret Wiley twelve Dollars and fifty cents for supplies furnished the draughted Militia under the command of Major Wood on their March to Annapolis as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ensign Edward Hroott eleven Dollars and two cents the amount of pay due him and five privates of the draughted Militia for marching from Montgomery County to Annapolis as per Pay Roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Smith seventeen dollars and seventy five cents for supplies furnished the Militia in April last as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer Esquire Pay Master to the twenty second Regiment eight hundred and ten Dollars and fifty nine cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Samuel Maynard for services in August last as per Pay Roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer Esquire Pay Master to the twenty second Regiment six hundred and seventy nine Dollars and one Cent the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Joseph Sazds for services at Annapolis in August last as per Pay Roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas Brewer Esquire Pay Master to the twenty second Regiment the sum of seven hundred and thirty five Dollars and
