

Thursday October the 7/1813.

The Council met. Present the honorable Alexander C. Maguider, William Bond Martin and Thomas G. Addison.

William Alexander was appointed Register of Wills for Cecil County in the room of David Smith deceased to hold the same until the meeting of the General Assembly and Commission for

Ignatius Davis was appointed a Justice of the Orphans Court for Frederick County in the room of Robert Burrising resigned and Commission issued to George Baer, John M. Sherman and Ignatius Davis as Justices of the Orphans Court for said County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw Seventy one dollar and twenty four cents forundry articles furnished the State as per account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Peacock the sum of three hundred and forty eight dollars and twenty nine cents being the balance of his own account and the one of Thomas Henrix that had been assigned to him for provisions furnished the Cavalry of Talbot County in May last as per account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Frost the sum of two dollars for hauling one load of Chancery Records from the Vineyard to Annapolis as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Murroe Post Master at Annapolis the sum of one hundred and seventeen dollars and eighty cents the amount for Postages for the Executive as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Miss Sarah G. C. Smith twenty dollars for damage done to her house while in the occupation of the Militia at Annapolis as per account filed and passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Waters the sum of six hundred and sixteen dollars and thirty seven and a half cents for making Pistols, Hobsler, Scabbards and so forth as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Brooke twelve dollars for transmitting the baggage of Soldiers from Prince Georges to Annapolis in August last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Praher three dollars for taking down boulder and so forth in a house in Upper Marlborough in the reception of the Records of the State as per account passed and filed.
