By the Petition of St. Legez Meeks of Kent County it appears that he was fined by the Judges of Kent County Court at September term last for keeping a Billiard table without licence. The Petitioner states that he has for a number of years kept an ordinary and has also kept a Billiard table. That in March eighteen hundred and eleven finding his Billiard table unprofitable he did not renew his licence to keep it for public use. That being under the impression that he had a right to keep a Billiard table running provided no charge was taken for playing thereat he permitted sundry persons to use the said table. He states that his offence has originated entirely from ignorance of the provision of the law and not from a wilful design to violate or evade the same. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County doremit the said fine.
