

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard. B. Watts the sum of seventy dollars and seventy five cents for a Waggon purchased of him by William Ross for the use of the State as per Account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard. H. Scott the sum of fourteen dollars for riding express as per Account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Brown the sum of three dollars and six and a quarter cents for lead as per Account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Williams one hundred and nine dollars and twelve cents as per Account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross the sum of twenty dollars for rent and repairs of House as per Account passed.

By the Petition of Lloyd Sanham accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of Montgomery County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance with Rignal Buttard Zealock Burr of his securities himself in the sum of fifty dollars and his securities in the sum of twenty five dollars each for the appearance of the said Sanham at the said Court at March Term eighteen hundred and twelve to answer a charge of threatening Thomas Bridgett and for his keeping of the Peace. The Petitioner states that he did attend at the said Term the two first days of the Court with his securities, and that nobody appeared against him, on which being ignorant of the Law and supposing nothing more was to be done, he went home to his business, being Manager for Philip Barton Key Esquire. He further states that in a day or two after he left Court, the said Recognizance was called and forfeited, by which means he and his securities are burthened with a large debt without having committed any breach of the Peace or act against Law. The Board on consideration of all the circumstances of the case and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said Lloyd Sanham and his securities from the said Recognizance.
