

By the Petition of William Timmons a free Negroe it appears that being ignorant of the Laws
of the State and not intending to violate them he emigrated sometime ago from the Commonwealth
of Virginia and settled in the State of Maryland where he has a Wife (who is a Slave) and
several Children. He further states and the same is confirmed by the Certificate of several
respectable Gentlemen that since his residence here he has conducted himself honestly
orderly and industriously but that at Washington County Court October Term eight-
een hundred and thirteen he was indicted and fined one hundred and forty dollars
for the said offence and in default of payment to be sold for such term as will be
necessary to discharge the same. The Petitioner further states that he is entirely
unable to discharge said fine. The Board on consideration of which circumstances
and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said
William Timmons from the fine of one hundred and forty dollars.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Alexander G. Magruder
pay to Major Thomas A. Dorsey fifteen dollars for
Hay furnished for the use of the Militia at Annapolis April 1813. Thomas G. Addison

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Green fifty dollars and
twenty five cents for advertisements and laundry articles furnished at her account

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross nine hun-
dred and five dollars and eighty seven and three fourths cents the balance of his
account number one as aforesaid. The account has been paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Timmins Ten dollars
for the hire of his Waggon for the Militia in April last as per account paid.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Solomon Lowe the sum
of six hundred and forty two dollars and Ninety eight cents the balance of the
aggregate amount of his account for supplying the Militia of Talbot County
including his Commission. The account has been paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mark Arthur two dollars and
fifty four cents for forage furnished a Troop of Horse at Elkton as per account paid

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Elija Timmins seven
dollars and twenty cents for beating the drum twenty four days near Elkton in
each other account has been paid and filed.
