

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major John Meredith thirty four dollars and twelve cents on account of his expenses in coming to Annapolis to procure arms and for other as per accounts Number one two and three passed and filed

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jacob Mitzgan one hundred and fifty dollars for six Months salary as Armourer at Frederick Town due twenty fifth of November

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Luntz Pay Master to the thirty seventh Regiment eight dollars and sixty six cents for his pay and for other as per account passed and filed.

ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Dennis Keall the sum of thirty dollars paid by him for Stage hire of three rich Soldiers of the draughted Militia from Baltimore to Hancock as per account passed and filed.

Tuesday December the 7 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout.

By the Petition of Nicholas G. Watkins of Anne Arundel County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of five pounds to appear at the said Court to answer a presentment for an Assault and Battery on a certain John Davis. The Petitioner states that he did attend from term to term with a view to traverse the prosecution but that owing to the absence of the State Witnesses he was unable to bring on the trial. The Petitioner states that at September term eighteen hundred and twelve he was confined to sick Bed and unable to attend in consequence of his absence the said Recognizance was forfeited. That he has a large family and his resources limited. The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said Recognizance of five pounds.
