

Thursday December the 9 1817.

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder, William Hand Martin, William Howard and James Boutwell.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Harwood Pay Master to the second Regiment two hundred and fifty nine dollars and ninety four cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Thomas T. Simmons for services in August last as per Pay Roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain William Dickinson one hundred and ninety seven dollars and seven cents the amount of pay due the Troop of Horse commanded by him for services in Talbot County in April and May last as per Pay Roll.

The account of David Long for fifty seven dollars and nine and a half cents for furnishing supplies to the Militia in Worcester County having been included in the account of Edward Stevenson Contractor for said County for which an order issued on the twenty fourth of September last for one hundred and ninety seven dollars and thirty four and a half cents the order in favor of said Long dated on the same day for the said fifty seven dollars and nine and a half cents was returned and cancelled.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Sturges Pay Master to the ninth Regiment five dollars and twenty cents the amount of his pay as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard J. Hall the sum of seventeen dollars for the hire of a cart and horse to transport provisions to the Militia and for an express as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Corneys the sum of two hundred and eighty one dollars and twenty three cents for supplies furnished the Militia of Cecil County in April last as per account passed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to David White twenty dollars for supplies furnished the Militia in April last as per account passed.
