Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Hannah Gatter five dollars and seventy five cents for supplies furnished the draughted Militia on their march from Cecil County to Baltimore in May last as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant William Saunders forty one dollars and seventy three cents for supplies and accommodations for the Militia and for the amount of pay due him as per account passed and filed

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Brown Brigade Quarter Master at Annapolis three hundred and two dollars and eighty five and a fourth cents for his pay and for his as per accounts number one and three filed

Friday December the 10 1813

The Council met Present His Excellency The Governor and The Honorable Alexander C. Magruder William Bond Martin, William H. Ward and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Armourer at Annapolis forward to Captain Samuel Slaughter of Caroline County forty Pistols forty Swords and forty Holsters for the use of his troop.

By the Petition of Aquilla Lenthicum of Anne Arundel County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered into two Recognizances for his appearance at Anne Arundel County at March Term eighteen hundred and twelve to answer two presentments for assaults and batteries committed on the bodies of Daniel Queen and Anne Queen. The Petitioner states that he is in the custody of the Sheriff and totally unable to pay the said forfeitures. The Board on consideration of all the circumstances of the case and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the whole of the said forfeitures except one dollar in each case.
