dollars for a breach of the Peace committed on Edward Berry. The Petitioner states
that he is in very narrow circumstances and that the payment of the above fine will greatly
disturb him & that he has always borne the character of a peaceable citizen. The Board
in view of the above instances & the case as given the recommendation of a number
of respectable persons inhabitants of said County do remit one half of the said fine of two
hundred dollars
