Benjamin Harris was appointed Coroner for Calvert County in the place of Harsham Parker Sheriff and commission issued to him accordingly.

From Friday 24th to Wednesday the 29th of December Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Samuel Bidout and Alexander Cortie Magruder.

Wednesday December 29th 1813

The Council met Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honorable Samuel Bidout and Alexander Cortie Magruder. Thomas G. Addison appeared in the Council Room and qualified before Louis Gapaway Esquire a Justice of the Peace for Anne Arundel County by taking the several oaths required by the Constitution and Form of Government and Laws of this State; by making and subscribing a declaration of his belief in the Christian Religion, and also by taking an oath to support the Constitution of the United States.

By the Petition of Sam Swearingen accompanied by a Transcript from the proceedings of the Court of Montgomery County it appears that he was fined by the said Court at November term last thirty Dollars for a breach of the Peace. The Petitioner states that he is in very low circumstances with a wife and family to support, and has no means of paying the said fine, having given up all his property for the benefit of his creditors. The Board in consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons inhabitants of the said County do remit the whole of the said fine.
