

Ordered for attendance and Medicine furnished the Militia of Colonel Samuel Watkins's Regiment as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that James Ligon and John ... be appointed and commissioned Judges of the Superior Court for Charles County.

Ordered that John Dyson, Samuel Hawkins, Samuel Chapman, Joseph Green, Thomas Davis, Philip Ford and Thomas Rice were appointed and commissioned Justices of the Peace for Charles County.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Wright fourteen Dollars and fifty cents for Bacon furnished the Militia of Kent County as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Caspar H. Jones fifty nine Dollars and twenty six cents for his pay as Quarter Master and for supplies furnished the Militia of Kent County as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nathaniel Comoggy thirteen Dollars and thirty three and one third cents for Bacon furnished the Militia of Kent County as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Edward Neesall twenty six Dollars and eighty seven and one half cents for Powder and Lead furnished the Militia of Kent County as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to P. Ward, Basin & Co fifty seven Dollars and fifty cents for provision and ammunition furnished the Militia of Kent County as per account papered and filed.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justices of the Peace and other officers of the usual appointment till tomorrow.

Wednesday January the 5th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor, and the honourable William Bond Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Alexander Contee Magruder.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and law to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till tomorrow.

Thursday January the 6th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor, and the honourable William Bond Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Henry Ashton of the 43rd Regt fifty nine Dollars and eighty six cents the amount of pay due him for services in July 1813 as per account papered and filed.
