Friday January the 7th 1814

The Council met. Present his excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond Martin Thomas G. Addison and Alexander Centee Naguider.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Clement Brooke Paymaster to the 3^d Regiment twenty Dollars for his expences as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Wells Quarter Master one hundred and two Dollars and forty eight cents as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Pendell four Dollars and twenty six and an half cents for Ferrages for Militia &c as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Gaparway Watkins ten Dollars and fifteen cents for his pay and Rations on marching to the City of Annapolis to take command of the Drafted militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George D. Atkinson fifty three Dollars and twenty cents for Ammunition Lead &c as per account papered and filed.
