Saturday January the 7th 1814

The Council met Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond Master Thomas G. Addison and Alexander Conte Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Clement Brooke Paymaster to the 3^d Regiment twenty Dollars for his expences as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Wells Quarter Master one hundred and two Dollars and forty eight cents as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Pindell four Dollars and twenty six and an half Cents for Fornages for Militia as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Gapaway Watkins ten Dollars and fifteen Cents for his pay and Rations on marching to the City of Annapolis to take command of the Drafted militia as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George D. Atkinson fifty three Dollars and twenty Cents for Ammunition Lead &c as per account paid and filed.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and Law to be appointed annually and not having come to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till tomorrow.

Saturday January the 8th 1814
