Tuesday January the 11th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William Bond Martin Thomas G. Addison and Alexander Cottee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Daniel Siller one hundred and nine
to two Dollars and fifty cents for 770 lbs of lead in per account papers and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Reyon Spence fifteen Dollars for the
rent of a Magazine for twelve months to the benefit of the soldiers as per account papers and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to "Lucy" Steel an White Twenty nine
Dollars for the rent of a Magazine for twelve months as per account papers and filed.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other
officers directed by the Constitution and Law to be appointed annually and not having come
to a conclusion postponed the further consideration thereof till to morrow.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Gottel J. Gramma twenty seven
dollars and twenty six cents for soap furnished for the militia at Annapolis.
