

Friday January 16th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond Martin Samuel Risted and Alexander Carter Magister.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the State be pay to John Faistow Thirty Dollars for horses to accommodate the Militia while on duty in Saint Mary's County in July as per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the State be there pay to Charles Turner five Dollars for the use of a lot of grass for the Cavalry horses per account passed and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the State be there pay to Captain Christopher Hughes three hundred Dollars for two field pieces four pounds purchased of his Company for the use of the State of Maryland.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution which may be appointed annually and not to come to a conclusion until the further consideration thereof till to morrow.
