

Friday January 16th 1816

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond, Martin Samuel Bidout and Alexander Coote Magister.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Fasten thirty Dollars for houses to accommodate the Militia while on duty in Saint Marys County in July as per account paper, and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles Turner five Dollars for the use of a lot of grass for the Cavalry Horses as per account paper, and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Christopher Hughes three hundred Dollars for two field pieces four pounders purchased of his Company for the use of the State of Maryland.

The Council resumed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers directed by the Constitution and law to be appointed annually and not as they come to a conclusion yet to be held in further consideration hereof till to morrow.
