

Committee of Supplies in Baltimore three thousand nine hundred and forty four Dollars and seven
Cents & being to much of the account of said Committee as aforesaid.

The Council postponed the further consideration of Justice of the Peace and other offices of
annual appointment till Thursday.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Alexander Smith Quarter Master to the Eleventh Regt
Dorchester County two hundred & twenty seven Dollars and twenty nine Cents for rations furnished said Reg't in April & May 1813 as per
account paper'd & filed. Monday January 17th 1815

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honorable William Bond,
Master Samuel Reddick and Alexander Condie Augurall.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to C. J. Trapier de Menevilles & Co
fourteen hundred and forty Dollars for Ropes furnished General Benton as per account
paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Steakes Twenty six Dollars
and seventy one Cents for Wine & Spirit furnished by order of General Benson for the Fort at
St Michaels as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Spencer forty six Dollars
for wood and straw furnished the Militia at St Michaels as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Kemp twenty two Dollars and
fifty Cents for wood furnished the Militia at St Michaels as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Broadway and Joseph Kemp
forty eight Dollars and thirty three and one third Cents for sawing 3500 feet of Inch Plan for
the Batteries at St Michaels by order of General Benson as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Dorgan eighty Dollars and
twelve two Cents for mounting Cannon and sundry other Work and furnishing straw at
St Michaels by order of General Benson as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Sangster Paymaster to the 19th
Regiment fourteen Dollars and four Cents on account of Captain White's Pay Roll now before
omitted in said Roll for services in August 1813.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Woolford fourteen Dollars
and eighty three Cents on account of his expences in going to Annapolis for Arms & for the militia
as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Christian Faughn eleven Dollars
and sixty two and an half Cents for supplies furnished the Draughted Militia under the
command of Lieutenant Beall as per account paper'd and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to L Price fourteen Dollars on ac-
count of supplies furnished the Draughted Militia under the command of Lieutenant
