The Council of the Western Shore considered the petition of the said Justice of the Peace and other officers of the said County and the same was referred to the next meeting of the Council.

Monday January 18 1781

The Council met at the Court House in the City of Annapolis and the Honorable William Bond Martin Samuel Bond and Alexander Gentry Magister.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Bond and thirty six Dollars and thirty two cents for his pay for his services in April and May last as per account papered and filed.

The Council renewed the consideration of the appointment of Justices of the Peace and other officers vacated by the constitution and have to reappoint as a matter of course not having come to a decision postponed the further consideration thereof for the present.

Monday January 19 1781

The Council met at the Court House in the City of Annapolis and the Honorable William Bond Martin Samuel Bond and Alexander Gentry Magister.

William S. Sillars and Samuel Gentry of the County were appointed Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a new Commission issued for said County including them and leaving out William Williams of Rehoboth.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Edmondson sergeant Major of the Extra Battalion in General Mifflin's Brigade seven Dollars and ten cents for his pay for August last as per account papered and filed.
