

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor Thomas Wellington forty Dollars and fifty one Cents for his pay as acting Surgeon in the 33<sup>rd</sup> Regiment as per pay roll of the Staff and field officers signed by General Charlemain.

Tuesday January 18<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H Ward, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Leydon eight Dollars and forty Cents the amount due a detachment of Militia ordered by Colonel Potter to take charge of some Devastation at Denton as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Leydon twelve Dollars and seventy five Cents for cleaning and removing arms in Caroline County in May last as per account paid and filed.

John Burnall was appointed Sheriff for Prince Georges County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Saturday January the 29<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H Ward, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Gleaves Paymaster to the 35<sup>th</sup> Regiment two hundred and fifty seven Dollars and sixty eight Cents the amount of pay due the Company Commanded by Captain W Park for services in August last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Reuben Reynolds twenty Dollars for a Bag of Powder furnished the Militia under the command of Major Potter as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Thomas Harris sixty Dollars for Forage and horses furnished the Militia stationed at his farm in Kent County as per account paid and filed.

William N. Williams and John Stewart were appointed Justices of the Peace for Baltimore County and a new commission issued to the said County including them.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Peaco three Dollars and eighty one and three fourths Cents for a pair of scales and weights and two Brass locks for the use of the Militia at St. M's Point as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Brown fifty four Dollars the amount of his Account for Proclamations &c. inserted in the Hager Town Gazette as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Givens forty two
