Jonathan Greenwood was appointed Notary Public for Cecil County to reside at Federick Town and Commission issued to him accordingly.

George Midd was appointed Notary Public for Cecil County to reside at Port Deposit and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Morris Paymaster to the 25th Regiment fifteen Dollars for his pay while in service in May last as per account pasted and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Fenwick a private in Capt. N. Cousins Company of Cavalry six Dollars and sixty three Cents the amount of his pay for services in July last omitted to be inserted in the list.
