Ordered that Mr John Shaw forward to Port Tobacco to the care of Captain Stonestreet forty  
one Rifles forty Pistols forty holsters four thousand Cartridges and five hundred flints the  
Rifles for Captain Blackiston of Saint Mary's County the Pistols and Holsters for Captains  
Stonestreet and Captain of Charles County and the Cartridges and flints to the direction  
of General Hawkins.

From Thursday the third to Monday the seventh of February inclusive Present his  
Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Samuel Ridout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Tuesday February the 8<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Thomas  
G. Addison, Samuel Ridout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Benjamin Williams having appeared on the Council Chamber and executed and  
acknowledged her bond as keeper of the Penitentiary House in Baltimore County before  
the Governor and Council a Certificate directed to be given him of the execution of said  
bond and of his appointment in the room of Nathan Slymon removed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to C. J. McSheime Prentiss  
Frederick Town fifteen Dollars and seventy five Cents the amount of his account for painting  
as per account papered and filed.

Wednesday February the 9<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Thomas G.  
Addison, Samuel Ridout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Archibald N. Maugh and Joseph C. Miller were appointed Justices of the Peace  
for Washington County and a new commission issued to said County including them.

The following persons were reappointed Inspectors of Tobacco at the respective Ware  
houses in Saint Mary's County viz. At Chaptico ware house Joseph Shannell. At Leonard  
Town ware house John Stone.

Thomas Gardner was appointed and commissioned Inspector of Tobacco at Llewellyn  
Ware house in Saint Mary's County.
