Ordered that Mr John Shaw forward to Port Tobacco to the care of Captain Stonestreet forty  
one Rifles forty Pistols forty Holsters five thousand Cartridges and five hundred flints the  
Rifles for Captain Blackston of Saint Marys County the Pistols and Holsters for Captains  
Stonestreet and Cannon of Charles County and the Cartridges and flints to the direction  
of General Hawkins.

From Thursday the third to Monday the seventh of February inclusive Present his

Tuesday February the 8<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Thomas  
G. Addison Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Benjamin Witham having appeared in the Council Chamber and executed and  
acknowledged his bond as keeper of the Penitentiary House in Baltimore County before  
the Governor and Council a Certificate directed to be given him of the execution of said  
bond and of his appointment in the room of Nathan Hinson removed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to C. J. Melshimer Printer at  
Frederick Town fifty one Dollars and seventy five Cents the amount of his account for printing  
as per account papered and filed.

Wednesday February the 9<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honourable Thomas G.  
Addison Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Archibald M. Maugh and Joseph C. Keller were appointed Justices of the Peace  
for Washington County and a new Commission issued to said County including them.

The following persons were reappointed Inspectors of Tobacco at the respective Ware-  
houses in Saint Marys County viz. At Chaptice Ware house Joseph Shannmell. At Lemons  
Town Ware house John Stone.

Thomas Gardner was appointed and commissioned Inspector of Tobacco at Newellins  
Ware house in Saint Marys County.
