Friday February the 11<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Thomas G. Addison, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Havers twelve Dollars for hire of carts and Horses to bring Records from Marlborough as per accounts papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Brewer twenty four Dollars for four days hire of a Waggon to bring Land Records from Marlborough to Annapolis as per account paper and filed.

Nicholas S. Watkins and Lewis Neth Junior were appointed Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a new Commission issued to said County including them.

John Cottingham Senior (Pocomoke) was appointed Justice of the Levy Court of Worcester County vice John Selby Senior and a new Commission issued to John Holloman, John P. Marshall, William Corbin, Robert Mitchell, John S. Martin, William McGehee and John Cottingham Senior (Pocomoke) as Justices of the Levy Court for Worcester County.

Saturday February the 12<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable Thomas G. Addison, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Luther Marten was appointed Counsel on the case of Gotlieb Sholer against the Tenants of Nanticoke Manor, to attend to a Commission that was ordered by the Circuit Court of the United States, for the examining of Witnesses in the State of New York, and to defend the said suits, pursuant to a resolve of the General Assembly at its last Session.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Luther Marten Esquire Three hundred Dollars as Counsel for the Tenants of Nanticoke Manor, and to execute the duties imposed by a resolve of the General Assembly at its last Session.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Colonel Richard Waters Brigade Quarter Master one hundred and fifty six Dollars and eighty Cents it being the balance of his account.

Henry Vanvickle was appointed Justice of the Peace for Hartford County and a new Commission issued to said County including them.
