Resolves that in case of any indication of the approach of the Enemy any Member a Member  
of the Executive who may be at the seat of Government, are authorized to direct a removal to the  
Town of Upper Marlborough of the Public Records and Papers now in the City of Annapolis.  
The Board is also of opinion that when it shall have been necessary to remove the Records  
and Papers it would be improper to authorize a return of any of them, for any purpose,  
while danger is apprehended.

and Hall as Contractors at Annapolis.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Murray one hundred  
and sixty eight Dollars and twenty four Cents amount of order in his favour drawn by  
William Pop late Surveyor at Annapolis and to be charged to said Pop in his account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Pop twenty one Dollars  
sixty and half Cents the balance due on his accounts No 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6. papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Joseph Henry three thousand  
seven hundred and fifty seven Dollars and seventy five Cents the balance of his account for  
muskets, Swords, Pistols, wipers, screwdrivers and so forth as per account dated November 26<sup>th</sup>  
last papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer pay to William Alexander three Dollars and twenty Cents for  
Candles furnished the militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Alexander and Robert  
Welch Contractors for Anne Arundel County one hundred and seventeen Dollars and seventeen  
Cents the balance of their Accounts papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John H. Sickle sixty three Dollars and  
seventy five Cents for hire of Balteaux as per account papered and filed.
