of the Executive who may be at the seat of government, be authorized to direct a removal to the

The Board is also of opinion that when it shall have been necessary to remove the Records
and Papers it would be improper to authorize a return of any of them, for any purpose,
while danger is apprehended.

William Ross late Surgeon at Annapolis and to be charged to said Ross on his account.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Ross twenty one Dollars
sixty and half Cents the balance due on his accounts No 1. 2. 3. 4. 5. 6. paged and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Joseph Henry three thousand
seven hundred and fifty seven Dollars and seventy five Cents the balance of his account on
muskets, Swords, Pistols, wipers, screwdrivers and so forth as per account dated November 26th
