Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Bussey forty eight Dollars and fifteen Cents for pay due as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Captain Bussey seventeen Dollars and one twenty two cents for pay due as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel John Jones three Dollars for transporting Commission from Carlton to the place of deposit as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Farmers Bank of Maryland twelve Dollars for Wagon hire in removing Records of the Chancery Court as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Keene Paymaster to the 68th Regiment seventy one Dollars and eighteen Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain George Lake for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Keene Paymaster to the 48th Regiment Ninety six Dollars and six Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain William Williamson for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Keene Paymaster to the 68th Regiment eighty two Dollars and fifteen Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Samuel Totten for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Keene Paymaster to the 68th Regiment one hundred and four Dollars and thirty six Cents the amount of pay due the field and staff officers of said Regiment as per pay roll.
