Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel John Jones three Dollars for transporting communication from Carbon to the place of deposit as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Farmers Bank of Maryland twelve Dollars for Wagon hire in removing Records of the Chancery Court as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Heene Paymaster to the 48th Regiment seventy one Dollars and eighty seven Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain George Lake for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Heene Paymaster to the 48th Regiment ninety six Dollars and six Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain William Hammara for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Heene Paymaster to the 48th Regiment eighty two Dollars and fifteen Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Daniel Totten for services in April last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Heene Paymaster to the 48th Regiment one hundred and four Dollars and thirty six Cents the amount of pay due the field and staff officers of said Regiment as per pay roll.
