

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Lieutenant Israel Bowman of Captain Bupper Company of draughted Militia twenty three Dollars and fifty four cents the amount of pay due for his services at Garry's River under the Presidents requisition and allowed by a Resolution of the Legislature at the last Session, the account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Ensign Garbin Grafton of the 40th Regiment of militia ordered into service under the Presidents requisition twenty seven Dollars and eighty three cents the amount of pay due him for services & allowed by the Legislature at the last Session the account paid and filed.

Colonel Waters requested to have the arms that are in General Smith's possession cleaned and put into Boxes.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters two hundred and eighty two Dollars and seventy five cents the amount paid by him for Lead Camp Hells Gate as per account and vouchers filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Bodenhamer ninety two Dollars and sixty and an half cents for supplies furnished the draughted Militia ordered to Baltimore as per three accounts paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Augustine Gambrill four Dollars and thirty five cents for supplies furnished a detachment of militia ordered by General Williams to carry boats to Annapolis in April last as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Doctor William Marshall Junior twenty three Dollars and sixteen and one third cents for Medical attendance and medicines furnished the Militia on service in Prince George County and for a Waggon for transportation of the Militia as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to the Honourable Jeremiah T. Chase Six Dollars for eight hundred weight of straw furnished Hunter and Hall for the use of the Militia in April last as per account paid and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Green sixty seven Dollars and fifty cents as per account paid and filed.

By the Petition of James Wheeler of Charles County accompanied by a Transcript from the Proceedings of the Court of the said County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of one hundred pounds for the appearance of a certain John B. Milstead at the Court of the said County at March term eighteen hundred and twelve to answer a presentment and so forth. The Petitioner states that the said Milstead left the County some time previous to the date of the term and went to New York where he has resided ever since.
