Lewis Medley was appointed Contractor for Saint Marys County and allowed at the following rates viz^t eighteen cents per Ration for Infantry and twenty five cents per Ration for Cavalry.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mr^s Henrietta Ogle Eighteen Dollars for a Batteau rendered useful in the service of the militia at Annapolis in April last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Richard Simpson thirteen Dollars and fifty cents for articles furnished the militia in May last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George W. Porter twenty three Dollars and seventy five cents for cleaning and keeping in order sixty two muskets, altering locks & by order of Colonel Wilson as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major John Meredith one hundred and eighteen Dollars and fifty five cents on account of a Quarters salary as Militia accountant of the Eastern Shore and for Stationary and postage as per account papered and filed.
