Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters three
hundred and four Dollars and twenty eight Cents being the balance due from up to April
the eighth as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters Brigades
Quarters Master six hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Rezin Spiercer fifteen Dollars
for one Quarters Rent of the Magazine due the 12th Instant as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas L. Dawson Paymaster
to the 49th Regiment two hundred and eighty one Dollars and twenty nine Cents the amount
of pay due the Company commanded by Captain Andrew C. Smith for services in April
and May last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay Nicholas L. Dawson paymaster to
the 49th Regiment seventy one Dollars the amount of pay due the Company commanded by
Captain Allen for services in April and May last as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Nicholas L. Dawson Paymaster
to the 49th Regiment ninety nine Dollars and seventy and an half Cents the amount of pay
due the Company commanded by Captain W. Mackey for services in April and May last
as per pay roll.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Maxwell Quarters Master to the

49th Regiment one hundred and thirty one Dollars and twenty nine Cents the amount of pay due the
