Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Horatio Hudson four Dollars and twenty five Cents for supplies furnished a detachment of drafted Militia under the command of Lieutenant Matthias Head in May last as per account passed and filed.

Friday April the 22nd 1814

The Council met Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H. Ward, Samuel Ridout and Alexander Conlee Maguider.

By the Petition of Edward Lester of Cecil County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of fifty Pounds for his appearance at the Court of the said County to answer a presentment for an assault and Battery committed on John Sappington. The Petitioner states that his said Recognizance was respite from Court to Court till September term eighteen hundred and thirteen at which time he was discharged by William Alexander esquire the Prosecutor for the said County but the Court not being apprised of it ordered and directed the said Recognizance to be forfeited. The Board in consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do remit the said Edward Lester from the said forfeiture of fifty Pounds.
