The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H. Ward, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Maguider.

By the Petition of Edward Lester of Cecil County it appears that he entered into a Recognizance in the sum of fifty Pounds for his appearance at the Court of the said County to answer a presentment for an assault and Battery committed on John Sappington. The Petitioner states that his said recognizance was respited from Court to Court till September term eighteen hundred and thirteen at which time he was discharged by William Alexander Esquire the Prosecutor for the said County but the Court not being apprised of it ordered and directed the said Recognizance to be forfeited. The Board in consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of the Court of the said County do release the said Edward Lester from the said forfeiture of fifty Pounds
