Ward sixty Powder Horns, fifteen Screws, one pair of bullet moulds, sixty Belts and Scabbards, sixty two Chargers, sixty prickers and brushes, six wipers, one hundred and twenty flints and sixty Rifle Bayonets for the use of George W. Lightner's Rifle Company.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac McCormick two hundred and forty two Dollars for two six pounders furnished the Militia at Saint Michaels as per account papered and filed.
