Ordered that Mr Pinkney direct Colonel Waters to forward to William H. Ward sixty Powder horns, fifteen screws, one pair of bullet moulds, sixty Bells and Scabbards, sixty tin Chargers, sixty prickers and brushes, six wipers, one hundred and twenty flints and sixty Rifle Bayonets for the use of George. W. Lightners Rifle Company.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Isaac McKim two hundred and forty Two Dollars for two six pounders furnished the militia at Saint Michaels as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that The Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to H. Turner Quarter Master to the 45<sup>th</sup> Regiment one hundred and thirty one Dollars and ten Cents for articles furnished the militia as per account papered and filed.

William Hewitt and Elisha Joyce were appointed Justices of the Peace for Cecil County and a new commission issued to the said County including them

Nicholas L. Dawson was appointed Notary Public for the State of Maryland to reside at Elkton in Cecil County and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jesse Turner sergeant Major to the 45<sup>th</sup> Regiment eleven Dollars and forty seven Cents on account of militia services in July last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarter Master Thomas Brown one hundred Dollars to be by him accounted for.

James Parnott was appointed clerk of the Court of Appeals for the Eastern Shore and Commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Mumroe one hundred and five Dollars and twenty nine Cents on account of postage to the first Instant as per account papered and filed.
