

Saturday April the 23rd 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William H. Wood, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Giles G. Dyer was appointed Inspector of Tobacco at the Broad Creek warehouse in Prince Georges County in the place of Aquila Johns who declines accepting and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James D. Coe seven teen Dollars and eighty three Cents for services rendered at Annapolis as Sergeant Major to the Detachment of militia commanded by Major Waring as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that Mess^{rs} Grayson Still and Williams deliver to T Brown one Barrell of glazed musket powder and three Barrells of common powder.

Monday April 25th and Tuesday the 26th his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bidout and Alexander Magruder appeared in the Council room.

Wednesday April the 27th 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond Martin, Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Charles Forman four Dollars and fifty Cents for trail ropes and Straps for gun Carriages at ~~at~~ Have de grace as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Tucker ten Dollars and fifty Cents for seven days work in making gun Carriages as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Carver five Dollars and fifty Cents for work on gun Carriages as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Lade twenty one Dollars and twenty Cents for iron Work on Gun Carriages at Have de grace as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Platt Whitaker twenty one Dollars and thirty Cents for five hundred and twenty feet of scantling and nine day Work in mounting guns at Have de grace as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Wood fourteen Dollars and sixty two and an half Cents for plank furnished for the Battery at Have de Grace as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Jay one Dollar and seventy five Cents for spikes and laying the floor of the Battery at Have de Grace as per account papered and filed.
