The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond, Martin, Samuel Rideout and Alexander Cortes Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Heine Paymaster to the 42nd Regiment twenty three Dollars and four Cents the amount of pay due the Company commanded by Captain William Colston for services in August last as per pay roll.

John Young was appointed Register of Wills for Caroline County and commission issued to him accordingly.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William Monks thirty one Dollar and seven Cents for Powder and Lead furnished for the use of the Militia at Havre de Grace in April last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Smith Griffith and Co twenty one Dollars and twenty Cents for powder furnished for the use of the Militia at Havre de Grace in May last as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Bartol nineteen Dollars and fifty Cents for powder for the use of the Militia at Havre de Grace in April last as per account papered and filed.
