Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to W Tucker nineteen Dollars and sixty two and an half Cents for powder and shot furnished for the Militia at Havre de Grace in April last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Hogg and Co twenty one Dollars the balance due for money advanced for the purchase of powder for the use of the Militia at Havre de Grace in April last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Howes Goldsborough forty Dollars and one Cent for plank and powder for the use of the Militia at Havre de Grace as per accounts Nos 1 & 2 paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Valleau twenty Dollars for house rent for the Militia at Havre de Grace as per account paper and filed.

Friday April the 29<sup>th</sup> 1814

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William Bond Martin and Samuel Bidout and Alexander Contee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Keene seventy three Dollars and three Cents on account of supplies furnished the Militia in Dorchester County in October last as per account paper and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Mess<sup>rs</sup> Grayson, Still and Wilson two hundred and seventy two Dollars for powder for the State as per account paper & filed.

Ordered that the Ammunition at Easton deliver to Colonel James Brown or order one hundred and fifty keels one hundred Canlouch Boxes, two thousand Cartridges and two hundred flints.
