The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honorable William Bond, Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Ridout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Jonathan Pentney Cashier of the Farmers Bank of Maryland five hundred Dollars being for so much advanced by Nicholas Hammond President of the Branch Bank at Weston to Solomon Love Contractor for Talbot County as per receipt filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas Brown five hundred and ninety Dollars and ninety three Cents the balance of his account for ironing Gun carriage and expences in going to Bladensburg & as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Bennett Gough paymaster to the fourth Regimental Cavalry District forty eight Dollars for one months pay subsistence and forage as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Henry Deringer nine hundred and thirty nine Dollars for sixty Rifles purchased of him for the use of the State as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Major Henry James Gamoll five hundred Dollars to purchase supplies for the Militia to be by him accounted for.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Samuel Ogden two Dollars for the use of his cart oxen and driver for the transportation of arms &c as per account papered and filed.
