The petitioner states that at the same term he confessed a judgment which the said Gambrell agreed to accept for one Dollar and costs in a civil suit which the said Gambrell had instituted against the Petitioner for the said offence. The Petitioner states that the costs on the said civil suit in consequence of the number of witnesses the said Gambrell caused to be summoned amount to the sum of thirty eight Dollars and seventy three cents which will make the whole expenses of the said Criminal and Civil suits amount to at least fifty Dollars independant of the said fine of fifteen Dollars - The Board on consideration of which circumstances and from the recommendation of a number of respectable persons Inhabitants of said County do remit the whole of the said fine of fifteen Dollars except one Dollar.

The Council met. Present his Excellency the Governor and the honourable William Bond Martin, Thomas G. Addison and Samuel Bidout.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Williamson thirty five Dollars for two sets of Shift harness and two sets of leading harness for the State as per account papered and filed.

Doctor Richard Goldsbrough was appointed Judge of the Orphans Court for Dorchester County in the place of John Craig resigned and commission issued to Joseph E. Muse, Henry Heene of John and Doctor Richard Goldsbrough as Judges of the Orphans Court for Dorchester County.

Cornelius Howard was appointed Judge of the Orphans Court for Baltimore County in the place of Cornelius Howard Esq resigned and commission issued to Owen Dorsey, Samuel Owings of Stephen and Cornelius Howard as Judges of the Orphans Court for Baltimore County.

Benjamin Fowler was appointed Contractor for Charles County

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to General Philip Stuart two Thousand Dollars for the purpose of furnishing supplies to his Brigade to be by him accounted for.
