Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Adam Miller four hundred and forty five Dollars and twenty Cents for provisions furnished Joseph Mitchell by Wilmer and Palmer for the use of the Troops in Hunt County as per accounts papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Quarter Master Thomas Brown one hundred and eighty two Dollars and four cents the balance of his account for the transportation of Arms to Marlborough and Nottingham and for oats for the horses belonging to the State as per account papered and filed.

Saturday July the 11th 1814

The Council met Present his Excellency the Governor and the Honourable William Bond, Master, Thomas G. Addison, Samuel Ridout and Alexander Conlee Magruder.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Basil Talbot twenty one Dollars for the hire of his Cart and three Horses seven days at Nottingham for the use of the militia as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to John Rigby two Dollars and twenty five Cents for riding expences to Captain Waters and Lieutenant Nicholas as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Benjamin Lushby three Dollars for riding expences to Major Higgins as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Thomas G. Addison one Dollar and fifty cents on account of cash paid by him to sundry persons for loading the waggon and carts with the Land office Records as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Colonel Richard Waters Brigade Quarter Master at Baltimore six hundred and twelve Dollars and fifty one and an half cents the balance of his account from the eighth of April to the eighth instant as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to William McDonald and son sixty Dollars and sixty seven and an half cents for freight of arms from Philadelphia to Baltimore
