Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to James Green forty Dollars and fifty cents for publishing resolution respecting Public Debts, supplement to Militia law and thereby to grant blank marriage licenses as per account papered and filed.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to George Shaw one hundred and eleven Dollars and ninety five cents for paper 2 mills a for the State as per account papered and filed.

Richard J. Harrison was appointed Justice of the Levy Court for Queen Annes County in the place of Samuel Betts dead and Commission issued to Benjamin Hallow, James Mafey, Gideon Emory, John H. B. Emory, John Tilghman, Nathan Boynard and Richard J. Harrison as Judges of the Levy Court for Queen Annes County.

Ordered that Brigadier General Stuart be authorized to purchase four horses for the use of the Artillery attached to his Brigade.

Ordered that the Armorer deliver to Clement Dorsey Esquire fifty Artillery Swords for the use of the artillery of General Stuart's Brigade.

Ordered that the Treasurer of the Western Shore pay to Horatio G. Mumme forty five Dollars and forty and an half cents the amount of his account for paper & furnished the Executive as per account papered and filed.

Samuel Gover and Frederick Machubin were appointed Justices of the Peace for Anne Arundel County and a new Commission issued to said County including them.

Wednesday July the 13<sup>th</sup> 1784

The Council met. Present His Excellency the Governor and the honorable William Bond Minton, Samuel Ridout and Alexander Contee Maguire.

William P. Ridgaway, Arthur Segar, George M'Ginnis and William North were appointed Justices of the Peace for Queen Annes County and a new Commission issued to said County including them and leaving out Doctor John Perkins.

Ely Dorsey Senior was appointed Justice of the Levy Court for Montgomery County in the place of Richard Beall resigned and Commission issued to William Danne Senior, Thomas G. [unclear], Richard West, Thomas Fitchell, Luke [unclear], Jere [unclear] and [unclear].
